Approved School Re-opening Timeline (tentative)

The following is a tentative school re-entry timeline. The intention of this timeline is to get an increasing number of students into our buildings for in person learning opportunities. We will continue to support in person learning opportunities and stress the importance of safety measures. Each group of students will come into the building after the starting date in a rotational basis. Most will not be in on a daily basis. Additional information will be coming from our schools in the near future.

Presently in each building:

Idlehurst: Kindergarten, students receiving services, identified at risk students, preschool students.

Maple Wood: Grade 3 students, students receiving services, identified at risk students.

SMS: Grade 6 students, students receiving services, identified at risk students

SHS: 9 specific classes, students receiving services, identified at risk students

CTC: Year 2 students

Starting January 25, 2021 (Semester change)

SHS: 9 New classes coming into the HS, and continuing previously identified groups

CTC: adding Year 1 students

Starting February 8, 2021:

Idlehurst: Grade 1 and continuing previously identified groups.

Maple Wood: Grade 4 and continuing previously identified groups.

Starting February 15, 2021

SHS: an additional 8 classes are coming in and continuing previously identified groups.

Starting March 1, 2021 (after February break):

Idlehurst: Grade 2 and continuing previously identified groups.

Maple Wood: Grade 5 and continuing previously identified groups.

SMS: Grade 7 students and continuing previously identified groups.

SHS: 9 additional classes will be coming in with previously identified groups

March 15, 2021:

SMS: Grade 8 (Staff dependent)

Starting May 3, 2021 (After April Break)

** All students district wide re-entering school in Phase 4

Other points for consideration:

** COVID management for symptoms, close contacts, positive cases etc. will be managed in an ongoing fashion, as per recommendations from DHHS.

** We will continue to utilize all safeguards for staff and students

** Transportation will be monitored and adjusted as needed. If you have the ability to drop your child off at school, that would help the total number of students on each bus.

** If your child has any symptoms or is feeling ill, notify the school and keep them at home.

** Food service will continue with both onsite and delivery of meals

**We will continue to offer remote education

** All district devices that have been loaned to students will need to be returned when/if we reach Phase 4.
